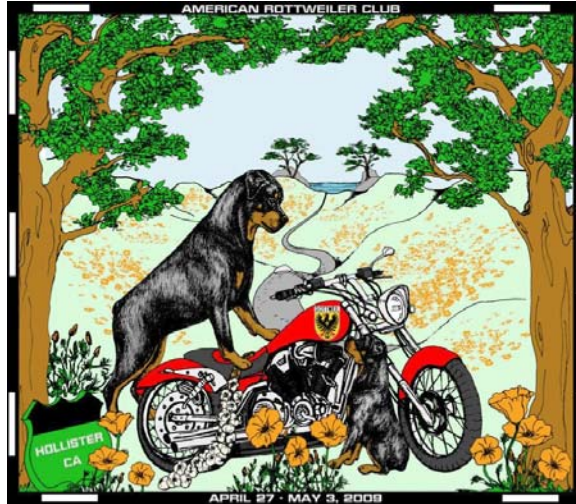

Notice to Exhibitors

Bitches in season may participate in accordance with AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8. Please keep bitches in season in your vehicle and notify the Test Secretary upon arrival. Please review Chapter 1, section 169 of the Tracking Regulations. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr., Ste 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. No conditional or phone entries will be accepted. Entry forms will not be accepted without fees or signature. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to closing of entries.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

There will be no refund, after closing date, of any dog accepted in the trial if no alternate is available. Refunds will be given to alternates unable to run.

All cancellations of entries must be made in writing to the Test Secretary and received prior to the stated date and time of closing of entries.

Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

No alcoholic beverages allowed.

In the event of extreme weather conditions the Club may take such action as necessary to protect the health and safety of the dogs, handlers and judges, including postponement or cancellations of the test.

Directions to San Benito Fairgrounds

From Hwy 101 traveling North or South exit EAST onto Hwy 156 (San Juan Bautista Hwy) Turn right on Union. Turn right on Hwy 25 to the fairgrounds.

Directions from San Benito Fairgrounds to Oakhill Ranch:

Exit the fairgrounds and turn Southeast on Airline Hwy (Hwy 25) toward Murphy Rd. Travel approximately 8 miles. Turn right on Old Airline Hwy. Ranch will be approximately .5 miles. Estimated time 10 minutes. Estimated distance 8.5 miles.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim or loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing the at of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
