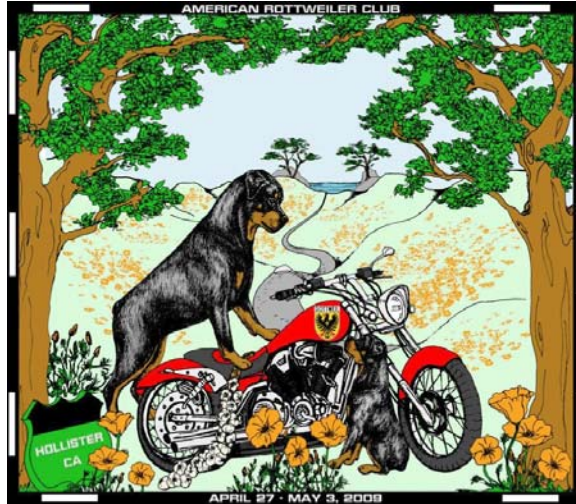

Notice to Exhibitors

Bitches in season may participate in accordance with AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8. Please keep bitches in season in your vehicle and notify the Test Secretary upon arrival. Please review Chapter 1, section 169 of the Tracking Regulations. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at www.akc.org. For a copy of the rule book write to: American Kennel Club, 851 Arco Corporate Dr., Ste 100., Raleigh, NC 27617-3390. To place a credit card order by telephone call: 919-233-9767 voice and 919-816-3627 fax. Minimum order is \$10.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. No conditional or phone entries will be accepted. Entry forms will not be accepted without fees or signature. Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to closing of entries.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trail Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

There will be no refund, after closing date, of any dog accepted in the trial if no alternate is available. Refunds will be given to alternates unable to run.

All cancellations of entries must be made in writing to the Test Secretary and received prior to the stated date and time of closing of entries.


Dogs must be kept on leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in the dog and handler being excused from the test site and the withholding of any awards.

An alternate list will be maintained and will consist of entries received by the closing date but not pulled in the initial draw. Drawing for the alternate list will immediately follow the drawing for entries that are to run.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California.

No alcoholic beverages allowed.

In the event of extreme weather conditions the Club may take such action as necessary to protect the health and safety of the dogs, handlers and judges, including postponement or cancellations of the test.

Directions from San Benito Fairgrounds to: Evergreen Valley which will be the first Test site

Evergreen Valley College: 3095 Yerba Buena Rd., San Jose, CA 95135

Exit fairgrounds and travel northwest on Airline Hwy (25) toward Quien Sabe Rd. Turn right onto Fairview Rd. Turn left onto McCloskey Rd., McCloskey Rd. will become Wright Rd. Turn right onto Bolsa Rd. travel approximately 10.5 miles. Merge onto US 101 north. Travel approximately 25 miles. Exit Blossom Hill Rd / Silver Creek Valley Rd. Turn right onto Silver Creek Valley Rd. Turn right onto Yerba Buena Rd. Make a U-turn at Valle Del Lago onto Yerba Buena Rd. Estimated travel time 1 hour. Estimated distance 52 miles.

Directions from Evergreen College to West Valley College:

West Valley College: 14000 Fruitvale Ave., Saratoga, CA 95070

Start out traveling West on Yerba Buena Rd. toward San Felipe Rd. and travel approximately 2.5 miles. Turn right onto Silver Creek Rd. and travel approximately .7 miles. Turn left onto E. Capitol Expressway and travel approximately 4.1 miles. Merge onto CA 87 South and travel approximately 1 mile. Merge onto CA-85 toward Mountain View and travel approximately 8.6 miles. Exit at Saratoga Ave. and turn left onto Saratoga Ave. Travel approximately .6 miles. Turn left onto Fruitvale Ave. and travel approximately .7 miles.

Directions from West Valley College to San Benito Fairgrounds:

Start out going North on Fruitvale Ave toward Allendale Ave. Turn right onto Saratoga Ave. Merge onto CA-85 South and travel approximately 13.5 miles. Merge onto US-101 South toward Los Angeles. Travel approximately 24 miles. Take Hwy 25 (Hollister/Pinnacles) exit and go back over the freeway. Approaching Hollister, turn left on Wright Rd. (shortly before 156/25 intersection), which turns into McCloskey. At the end of McCloskey, turn right onto Fairview. Continue to the 4-way stop and turn left on Hwy 25/Airline Hwy. Continue past Tres Pinos to Bolado Park.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the FAST titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
